### **AFGE National Council 222 Workplace Impact Survey**

**Dear Valued AFGE National Council 222 Employees,**

In the wake of recent unprecedented developments - from the OPM's "Fork in the Road" voluntary resignation communications to the wave of Executive Orders - we find ourselves at a critical juncture in federal service. Following our January 29th eAlert addressing these concerns, we are launching a workplace impact assessment survey to strengthen our position and protect your interests.

The events since January 20th have created ripples of uncertainty throughout our workforce. As your AFGE National Council 222 President, I want to assure you that every step we take is calculated to protect and preserve your rights and dignity as federal employees. Our January 29th guidance remains firm: do not make hasty decisions regarding voluntary resignations and await our detailed analysis.

**Today, we are asking for your crucial participation in our impact assessment survey.** This will:

- Document the real-world effects of recent federal workplace changes
- Gather essential data to support potential legal actions
- Help us identify areas where immediate support is needed
- Strengthen our collective bargaining positions

Your responses will be handled with the utmost confidentiality and will directly inform our responses to these challenges. The survey takes approximately 5 minutes to complete and includes sections on workplace impact, reasonable accommodations, and union engagement.

Remember: You are not alone in this journey. Together, we represent over 5,300 HUD employees, and every voice matters in this crucial moment.
