Today, February 12, 2025, despite our vigorous legal efforts to obtain a temporary stay of the resignation deadline, the court has not granted our requested relief. While this is not the immediate outcome we hoped for, your union continues to fight on every front to protect your interests.

Our Position Remains Firm

We maintain our strongest possible recommendation against accepting these voluntary resignation offers. The fundamental concerns we have raised remain unchanged:

- No guaranteed funding exists beyond March 14, 2025
- The proposal lacks binding contractual elements
- No protections exist for long-term benefits

During these challenging times, please know that your union stands firmly with you. We understand the pressure and uncertainty you face, and we remain committed to:

- Pursuing all available legal remedies
- Protecting your workplace rights
- Supporting you through this difficult period
- Fighting for your interests at every level
