**BREAKING NEWS: Court Grants Stay of February 6th Deadline
Until at Least Monday Afternoon February 10th**

Dear AFGE National Council 222 Members,

I am pleased to report that today, February 6, 2025, the court has granted our request for a temporary stay of the February 6th resignation deadline to at least Monday Afternoon February 10th. This immediate relief demonstrates the strength of our legal position and the validity of our concerns regarding the "Fork in the Road" proposal.

What This Means

- The February 6th deadline for voluntary resignations is temporarily suspended until Monday February 10th
- No immediate action is required from employees
- All existing work arrangements remain in place during this period

Next Steps

- AFGE National Council 222 will continue to work with our legal team
- We will provide detailed guidance as the court process unfolds
- Members should continue their normal work duties

Stay Informed

We will communicate all significant developments through our established channels. This temporary relief gives us the time needed to properly address these critical workplace issues through appropriate legal channels.

Thank you for your trust and patience during this challenging time. Your unity and professionalism continue to demonstrate the best of federal service.
